Highlights of the tour include: visiting Hart Plaza to view the statue honoring the Underground Railroad and the link to the companion statue in Windsor; this is also the site of the landing of the first Jew in Detroit; the markers in Milliken State Park honoring the first Jew here and the participation of the Michigan Jewish communities in the Civil War; the site of the first Jewish cemetery; the old neighborhoods of Lower and Upper Hastings; the old Temple Beth El now the Bonstelle Theater; Jewish participation in the Medical Center, Wayne State University and the Cultural Center; of course, many Albert Kahn buildings. including the DAC, 2 Beth El sites, the old Shaarey Zedek; the neighborhood around Ferry Park; the old Delmar area; Linwood and Dexter including old Durfee and Central High School; the northwest section including Adat Shalom, Mumford High School and other structures remaining in that area.
