Shimon Fogel has over 25 years of experience in Jewish communal advocacy, having served as the CEO of the Canada-Israel Committee from 2000 to 2010, having previously served as its Director of Government Relations. Prior to joining the CIC, Shimon Fogel served as the founding National Director of Community Services at Canadian Jewish Congress. As a long-time lobbyist and experienced community professional, he is fluent on the full range of public policy issues of concern to the Canadian Jewish community.

Shimon Fogel has served as a consultant to Parliament's Standing Committee on Foreign Affairs, and served as a member of the prestigious Round-Table on Global Security under the Department of National Defense. He regularly serves as a guest lecturer at universities in Canada and abroad.
